



SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

As part of Oklahoma Dance Center's commitment to its students, the community, and quality instruction for all students, we will be seeking scholarship funds and work-study arrangements for tuition, private lessons, coaching and rehearsal fees, and new choreography staged on our students.

The following will be required of all applicants:

- I. Submit all appropriate applications, providing all necessary information including:
 - a. Scholarship / Work-Study Application
 - i. Applicants most recent transcripts or report card
 - ii. Schedule of classes including instructor name and cost for which scholarship funds will be used
 - iii. Copy of most recent personal income tax return
 - b. Scholarship Requirements Form
2. Demonstrate a special talent for classical and/or contemporary dance. This will be determined by Oklahoma Dance Center Faculty.
3. Demonstrate a financial need. Applicants must demonstrate the inability to pay for their training based on annual income and familial circumstances. All parental financial income must be disclosed on the Scholarship Application which may be verified by means of contacting employers by scholarship granting bodies.

Final decisions will be made by the Scholarship Granting Body. Oklahoma Dance Center reserves the right to use this information to seek additional scholarship opportunities or granting bodies, and notification of scholarship awards will be made in writing as soon as such decisions have been made.

CRITERIA FOR MAINTAINING SCHOLARSHIPS

To remain in good standing and continue on scholarship students must:

1. Attend all classes, rehearsals and other scheduled Oklahoma Dance Center events. Absences due to illness or injury must be reported. An inordinate amount of absences as determined by the Scholarship Granting Body may result in the revocation of the scholarship.
2. Maintain steady improvement as determined by Oklahoma Dance Center faculty in each class for which the scholarship has been awarded.
3. Following the end of each school period in which a scholarship has been awarded, the student must complete an essay describing what the scholarship has meant to their development and assist in preparing any oversight documents required by the Scholarship Granting Body.

Additional criteria for the maintenance of the scholarship may be required on an individual basis as determined by the Scholarship Granting Body. Any additional criteria will be included in the notification of an award. Students who are offered a work-study agreement and complete and sign (along with a parent or guardian) the work-study contract must additionally follow all rules and obligations of that agreement.
